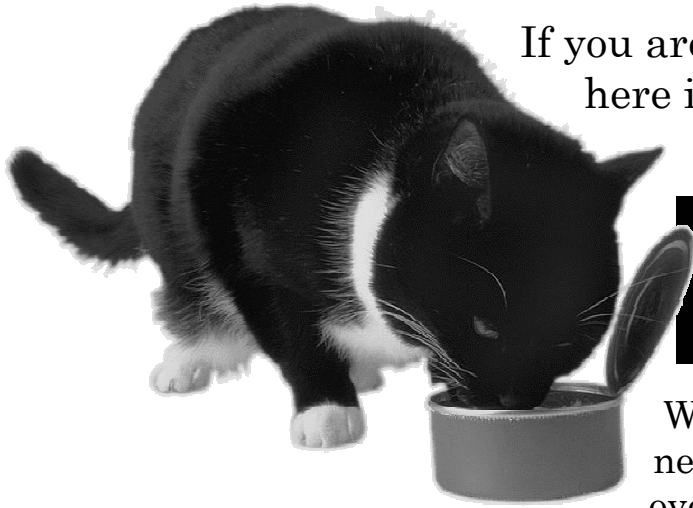


# Feeding a stray cat? We can help.



If you are feeding outdoor cats in your town here in Lake County, thanks for being a compassionate and good neighbor!

Let us help you control their population humanely, while improving their quality of life.

We can help you get these cats spayed or neutered so that they won't cause an overpopulation problem in your neighborhood, and so that they can live healthier lives.

**Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR)** decreases feral and stray cat populations without harming the cats. There are many benefits to TNR:

- The cats are **spayed or neutered**, never to breed again.
- The cats receive an “**eartip**”, which marks them as a sterilized animal belonging to a managed colony.
- The cats are **vaccinated against rabies**.
- The cats are returned to where they came from and are **managed by caretakers** who provide food, water, and shelter.
- Neutered cats make **better neighbors**—less howling, fighting, and no more litters of kittens!
